### ARRIVAL PROCEDURE FOR FRESH STUDENTS - 2024/2025 SESSION

Fresh students are expected to arrive at the Crown Estate Gate of the University as from 8.00am on Saturday, 28<sup>th</sup> September, 2024. Staff of Student Affairs, Registry and Bursary Departments will be on hand at the gate to receive them.

Students and parents are enjoined to co-operate with officials by following the procedures outlined below:

1. Allocation of hostel is strictly on the basis of first-come-first-served online with the assistance of ICT Unit.
2. Shuttle buses will be available to convey students with their belongings to designated hostels. Please note that parents will not be allowed to accompany their wards to the hostels.
3. All students must come along with originals of their receipts/tellers and letters of admission.
4. Upon arrival in the Crown Estate Gate, please report to the Finance Officer with the documents stated in (2) above, after which a bed space will be assigned to you. You will stay in the space allocated to you throughout the 2024/2025 Academic year except the authorities of the University deem it fit to effect a change.
5. All students must reside in the hostels, as the University authority does **NOT** permit off-campus residence.
6. All fresh students are to complete and produce 10 (ten) copies of Biodata forms and bring along on resumption.
7. All fresh students are to complete and produce 4 (four) copies of course registration forms and bring along on resumption.

## OBSERVANCE OF HOSTEL RULES

In addition to hostel regulations contained in the Student Handbook, the following rules shall apply in the hostels:

1. Cooking must be done only in the areas designated as kitchenettes.
2. Fighting and bullying of any sort is strictly prohibited: violation of this rule will be met with summary **expulsion**.
3. The University maintains a zero level tolerance policy on **cultism and other social vices**. Violators will be summarily **expelled**.

## WHAT TO BRING TO THE HOSTELS

- ❖ Bed sheet sets
- ❖ Laptops and personal computers are allowed but safety is at **owner's risk**
- ❖ Rechargeable lamps are allowed, but must be maintained at owner's risk
- ❖ Camp gas

## WHAT NOT TO BRING (PROHIBITED ITEMS)

- ❖ Low neck line clothes, spaghetti straps, tight clothes
- ❖ Any cloth that reveals upper extremities, mid-riff or other suggestive areas of the body or make for indecent dressing.
- ❖ Television or heavy stereo system with loud speakers.
- ❖ Generators, satellite TV (DSTV, etc.).
- ❖ Air conditioners
- ❖ Kerosene stove, Ring boilers and hot plates
- ❖ Weapon or **fire arms** of any kind
- ❖ Face cap and berets.
- ❖ Deep Freezer
